HENRY BEAUFORT SCHOOL

I was pleased to visit the science block at Henry Beaufort School this week. Originally built in the 1960s the science block consists of several classrooms but with large, single-glazed windows and very little insulation. The £3.4m refit project has insulated walls and roof, added solar panels, LED lighting, double-glazed windows, and new fittings and reduce energy consumption considerably.
